

- No food or drink is consumed in the lab and there is no evidence of food consumption such as wrappers, cups and utensils.
- Personnel wear the appropriate dosimetry.
- All persons handling radioactive material are designated as Nuclear Energy Workers (NEWs) and have been authorized and trained by Health Physics.
- All radioactive sources and containers of radioactive material are labeled with the Isotope, Activity, and the Reference Date.
- Contamination monitoring is performed at least weekly, and records are maintained.
- An accurate inventory of all radioactive material within the lab is maintained.
- Radioactive waste containers are used appropriately.
- Valid HPAC Permits are posted in each laboratory listed on the permit.
- Work is conducted within the Permit limits, only in the locations listed on the Permit and according to all of the Permit conditions.
- There have been no significant changes to the manner in which the work is conducted, or in the isotopes or quantities in use since the work was last approved by the Health Physics Advisory Committee (HPAC).
